- This 13 November 2024, there are 735 designated voting members representing 53 National Committees up to date with their dues and having sent their list of voting members; and 39 individual members from countries with no National Committees; that is a total of 774;
- The Credentials Committee's decision to add 10 potential voting members to the above, bringing the overall figure of possible voting members to 784;
